Krishnan Suthanthiran's Proud Canadian Party Announces A Vision For Canada

WASHINGTON, DC, UNITED STATES, April 24, 2025 — Dr. Krishnan Suthanthiran arrived in Ottawa, Canada in September 1969 as a graduate student admitted to Carleton University, Ottawa. He has invested hundreds of millions of dollars in multiple businesses in Canada, and has a keen interest in the well-being of all Canadians. Suthanthiran is also the President and Founder of the Proud Canadian Party (PCP)—a think tank—and what follows is a new vision for Canada.

Suthanthiran issued a press release in 2021 stating that former Prime Minister Justin Trudeau was the wrong leader for Canada. It took until earlier this year, with the resignation of Deputy Prime Minister and Finance Minister Chrystia Freeland, before more liberal MPs and Canadians sought the resignation of PM Trudeau. He resigned and called for the election of a new Liberal leader while suspending parliamentary activities. Mark Carney, former Governor of the Bank of Canada and Bank of England, was elected as the new leader of the Liberal Party on March 9th and assumed the duties of PM Trudeau. Subsequently, Carney sought Canada's Governor General to dissolve Parliament and call for a new federal election on April 28th, 2025. It is notable that as many as 7.5 million Canadians have already voted in this federal election, which will conclude by the end of the day on April 28th, 2025.

Suthanthiran has read the summaries of the leaders of the four parties—conservative, liberal, NDP, and BQ—from both the English and French debates and believes that of the four, the conservative leader seems to have somewhat of a vision, but still does not address all of the challenges facing Canada now and in the future.

The NDP leader focused on healthcare, including dental and pharmacare benefits, along with support for laid-off workers. While this is commendable, he completely missed the broader picture and a vision for all Canadians, as businesses are essential for creating jobs and stimulating economic growth.

The BQ leader focused exclusively on Quebec and its needs, with no plans for Canada as a bilingual and multi-cultural/multi-ethnic country.

PM Mark Carney leveraged U.S. President Donald J. Trump and vague support for NDP policies to sidestep controversies to either secure a majority or prepare to form a coalition government with the NDP in Ottawa. Carney lacked a compelling vision for Canada. Is Mark Carney merely wearing a mask and reiterating Trudeau's failed policies to win this election and become Prime Minister for the next four years?

The following is the vision of Suthanthiran for Canada and the future well-being of all Canadians.

1. Proportional voting.
2. Eliminating the trade barriers among Canadian provinces and territories.
3. Improving and expanding strong and mutually respectful defense and economic policies with the United States, Europe, Australia, India, New Zealand, and much of South/Southeast Asia.
4. A total revamping of the Canadian educational system—a total of 11 years of schooling, rebranding community colleges as regional colleges, free college tuition for Canadian citizens and 50% reduction for landed immigrants, affiliated with universities, a 3-year program for a diploma, with the ability to transfer all education with full credits to Canadian universities, and an additional one to three years for a bachelor's/master's degree.
5. National universal healthcare, including dental and pharmacare focusing on total health approach of prevention, early detection, and effective treatment for total cure, with hundreds of private non-profit, Pro Health Centers around the country—Proactive, Preventive, Primary, Medical, Dental and Eye Care Wellness Centers. Current centralized multi-billion dollar hospitals are the wrong approach for a very large country with the second largest land mass in the world. Canada needs a decentralized, hub-and-spoke model, operating 24/7.
6. The goal in revamped national healthcare should be to reduce the death and sufferings from cancer, cardiac, diabetes, infectious and other diseases by 50% or more.
7. A smart immigration policy that encourages and admits individuals with trade skills or higher education who have a job offer from a Canadian employer or to find employment. Housing must be decentralized by establishing satellite communities containing thousands of housing units, including multi-family and townhome concepts. This should be achieved through advanced and efficient housing construction in collaboration with large employers to subsidize housing costs.
8. Nearly 50% of the Canadian economy is managed by Asian Canadians. There has been a lack of appreciation or support for businesses in Canada. Business leaders have complained for many years about the lack of Canadian productivity and the anti-business policies of Canadian government agencies—too many and too powerful government agencies, stifling businesses and jobs. On the subject of growing the economy and fighting crime, the Conservative Party leader has the right ideas.
9. Canada needs a strategy to reduce the budget deficit by supporting and developing resource projects that Canada can generate billions of dollars in annual revenues.
10. Rethink and recreate new and better accommodations for the elderly such as assisted living at various levels as an alternative to nursing homes.
11. Plan to double the GDP within 15 years or less, using the strengths of Canada.

Will the new Prime Minister, after April 28, with a four-year term, have a great vision for Canada? Only time will tell.
